


Crafting with Mia: Making a Postcard

- 1. Get a heavier piece of paper and use scissors to cut it down to postcard size
- 2. Make your hearts! This can be through using...
 - a. Magazine or newspaper pages
 - b. Drawing and decorating a heart on plain paper
 - c. Painting a heart on heavy paper
- 3. Remember to use your imagination!
- 4. Cut out your heart(s) using scissors and attach it to the front of the postcard.
- 5. If you want to, decorate the blank spaces on the front of the postcard.
- 6. Flip your postcard over and draw a line hamburger style down the middle.
- 7. On the left side of the postcard, write your message to your friend or family member
- 8. On the right side of your postcard, draw in a space for the stamp on the upper right corner.
- 9. On the right side of your postcard, draw 3 or 4 lines in the middle for the name and address.
- 10. Send your postcard in the mail!

You will need:

- heavy paper
- scissors
- glue or tape
- drawing materials
- optional: cardstock or magazine pages
